Pray for the Sick in our Church and community. Pray for the healing hands of Christ to touch them and restore them to good health.

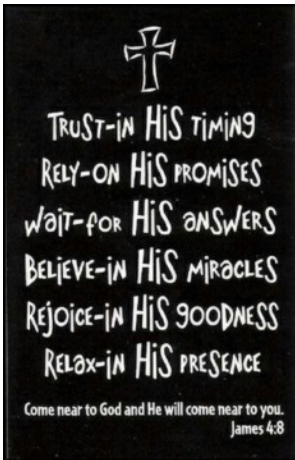
